Step 1: Server Installation


 **Important: SAP Business One demo Kit requires a local MSSQL Server (SP3)**

(1.1) Run SETUP.BAT and choose "Install"






(1.1) Choose "Server" installation



(1.2) Choose Customize and Business one 2005






(1.3) Select "Server Default"




(1.4) Specify your username and company name






(1.4) Choose "Custom"




(1.5) Set Destination folder






(1.7) Set the "Server Type" to MSSQL




(1.8) Provide User & Password for the SQL Server connection with administrative rights.





(1.9) Leave the defaults checked as is






(1.10) Once the Server setup process is completed, choose Server->Server Tools and install




(1.11) Choose "Custom" and choose installation folder

Step 2: Client Installation

(2.1) Run SETUP.BAT and hit Client




(2.2) Choose "Business One Client Application"






(2.3) Select the Destination folder and hit next.




(2.5) Restart your Machine> Once the system is restarted, SAP Business one Service Manager will be added to the system tray.



(2.6) Double-click on the SAP service icon (system tray) for launching the Service Manager, select "License Manager 2005", Start the service and check the "Auto start" option.



(2.7) SAP Business One Shortcut should appear on your Desktop






(3) TimeKeeper Add-on Installation

(3.1) Load SAP Business One and specify username and password. The default username is "manager", the default password is "manager".




(3.2) Load "Administration" from the Main menu






(3.3) Scroll to Add-on -> Add on Administration




(3.4) Press the Register Add-on button






(3.5) From the Pop up window choose for Registration Data File: TKINSTALLER.ARD and for Installation package: TKINSTALLER.EXE. Both files are available under SAP_B1_INSTALL\lavieAddOn. Make sure that Assign to Current Company and Activate for Company are both checked.




(3.6) From the Administration menu scroll to Setup->General->Users






(3.7) Add the new user to the system; the user must be a user that exists on Timekeeper users table.




(3.8) Login to the system using the new user code & Password
