Important:

- 1. If the server is used for both Terminal Services and MS-SQL, see "TK-SQL System requirements" document. Note that utilizing the same server for both Terminal Services and MS-SQL is not recommended (this might allow security breaches).
- 2. One of the known issues with terminal services is report generation due to the network "traffic" required (the report's data is sent to the local workstation). If there are selected workstations that generate reports that exceed 100 pages (e.g. 100 timecards), it is strongly recommended to purchase "Thin Print" software in order to reduce the network "traffic" and improve performance.
